COVID-19 Cases in Living Sky School Division from Oct. 8 to Oct. 11, 2021

A case or cases of COVID-19 were diagnosed in individuals in the following schools between October 8 to October 11, 2021:

- Norman Carter Elementary School (1 Case)
- Cut Knife Community School (1 Case)
- North Battleford Comprehensive High School (4 Cases)
- Connaught Elementary School (2 Cases)
- Bready Elementary School (1 Case)
- Lawrence Elementary School (1 Case)
- Battleford Central School (3 Cases)

We are working closely with Public Health staff to ensure necessary measures are in place to protect all students and staff.

Any individuals who were in close contact have been notified by the school or Public Health with directions. Following the division's health and safety protocols, the schools are receiving a deep cleaning/sanitizing and will remain open at this time.

Our school plans contain many important measures to decrease the risk of COVID-19 entering schools including promoting proper hygiene, implementing mask wearing, maintaining cohorts, and asking students and staff to stay home when experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms.
