COVID-19 Cases in Living Sky School Division (Maymont Central School and Lawrence Elementary School)

A case of COVID-19 was diagnosed in an individual in Maymont Central School and in an individual in Lawrence Elementary School in North Battleford. We are working closely with Public Health staff to ensure necessary measures are in place to protect all students and staff.

Any individuals who were in close contact have been notified by Public Health with directions. Following the division's health and safety protocols, the schools have received a deep cleaning/sanitizing and remain open at this time.

Our school plans contain many important measures to decrease the risk of COVID-19 entering schools including promoting proper hygiene, implementing mask wearing, maintaining cohorts, and asking students and staff to stay home when experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms.
